Reminders:

- As always, excellent attendance and punctuality is essential to maintain good progress.
- PE lessons are on **Monday** afternoons (outdoor kit) and **Thursday** mornings (indoor kit). Please ensure that your child has a suitable kit and that it is left in school for the whole of each half term.
- Children are encouraged to read every day, but are expected to read a minimum of at least three times a week, for fifteen minutes, and record this in their reading log. Reading books and logs need to be in school **every day**.
- When new spellings are sent home these need to be practised at least three times a week at home. Children will need to learn rules and spelling patterns and these will be tested in dictation sentences in class.
- Times Tables: Ten games will be set each week on Times Table Rockstars. If you do not have access to a computer or other technology please let me know and the sheets can be sent home instead
- Library sessions are on a **Thursday** and pupils will have the opportunity to change their library book on this day.
- Please make sure that all items of uniform are clearly labelled so that if items get lost they can be easily returned.

Learning Projects:

- Children will be set a Learning Project at the start of every term and this will run for six weeks. This term's project went out on the 19th January 2018.
- The project can come in once it is completed or by the deadline date of 2nd March 2018. Each class will host a learning gallery where parents can come and view the classes learning. You will be notified of this nearer the time.

- Club letters should now have come home. We are running a great programme of clubs this term.
