Reminders:

- As always, excellent attendance and punctuality is essential to maintain good progress.
- PE lessons are on **Wednesdays** and **Thursdays**. Please ensure that your child has a suitable kit and that it is brought in at the start of each week ready for the lesson.
- Children are encouraged to read every day, but are expected to read a minimum of at least three times a week, for fifteen minutes, and record this in their reading log. Reading books and logs need to be in school every day.
- Spellings will be sent home each week on a Monday and these need to be practised at least three times a week at home. Children will need to learn rules and spelling patterns and these will be tested in dictation sentences the following Monday. Grammar activities may also be sent home.
- Library sessions are on a **Wednesday** and pupils will have the opportunity to change their library book on this day.
- Please make sure that all items of uniform are clearly labelled so that if items get lost they can be easily returned.
- Times Tables: Ten games will be set each week on Times Table Rockstars. If you do not have access to a computer or other technology please let me know and the sheets can be sent home instead.

Learning Projects:

- Children will be set a Learning Project at the start of this term and this will run for six weeks. It will go out on 19th January 2018.
- The project can come in once it is completed or by the deadline date of 2nd March 2018. Each class will host a learning gallery where parents can come and view the classes learning. You will be notified of this nearer the time.
