

English

This term the children will be writing every day and learning how to apply their knowledge of grammar and spelling to a range of texts. They will be learning the skills to:

- Write a first person narrative based on the flying carpet ride in the story Journey.
- Writing a non-chronological report.

How to help your child at home:

- Read regularly with your child, (a minimum of 5 times a week) asking questions of the text.
- Please sign your child's reading record when you have heard them read or discussed the text with them.
- Support your child to learn their spelling words and the spelling rules.

Geography

We will be learning about the UK and then looking closely at our local area. We will be learning how to use maps to locate areas and developing our awareness of compass directions.

Art/D&T

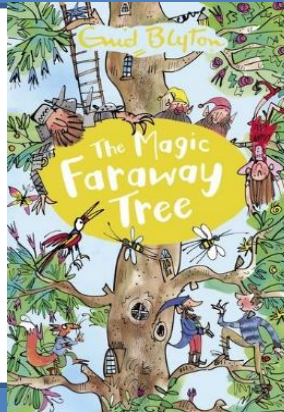
Our art work this term will be based around the book 'Journey', children will be making their own magic red door and exploring journeys through art.

Maths

- Written Addition
- Written Subtraction
- Problem Solving – Worded Problems
- Statistics – Interpreting Bar Charts and Tables
- Angles, Right Angles and Estimation
- Perpendicular and Parallel Lines, Vertical and Horizontal Lines
- 2-D Shape – Properties and Drawing
- Perimeter Including Problem Solving Using Written and Mental Methods

How to help your child at home:

- Help your child to learn to tell the time.
- Support your child to learn their times tables – by the end of year 4 the expectation is that children will know all of their times tables up to x12.



PSHE/Circle Time

In PSHE we will be focussing on Anti-Bullying, children will be exploring what bullying is and how to help prevent bullying in our school and community.

As a school we will be exploring the value of hope through circle time activities.

Science

- Through the curriculum, pupils will be investigating light and shadow.

How to help your child at home:

- Discuss how to be safe around electricity and note where electricity is used in our world.

Computing

Children will be learning how to develop safe and appropriate use of online technologies. Our topic is E-Safety and we will be exploring how to be responsible online citizens.

RE

This term we will be learning about Christianity; beliefs, ceremonies and celebrations.
