- Write a persuasive text
- Write instructions
- Write a discussion text
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How to help your child at home:

- Read regularly with your child, (a minimum of 5 times a week) asking questions of the text.
- Please sign your child's reading record when you have heard them read or discussed the text with them.
- Support your child to learn their spelling words and the spelling rules.
- Focus on cursive handwriting.

Geography

We will be learning about Rainforests, using the documentary "Our Planet" by David Attenborough as a stimulus.

Art/D&T

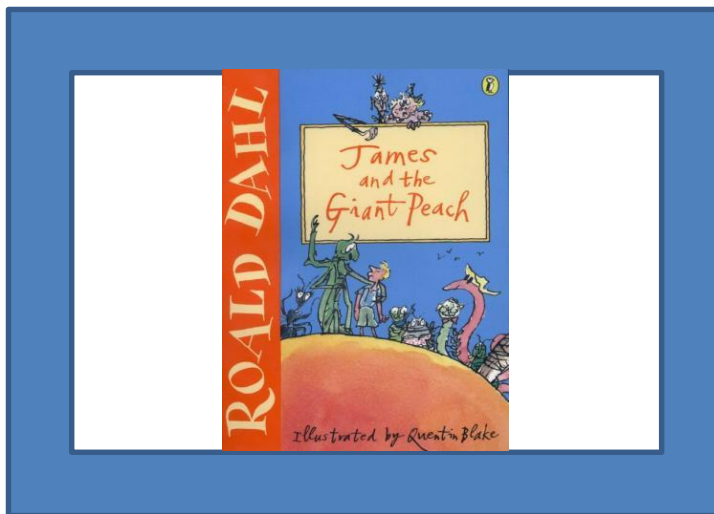
Our art work this term will be based around plants - the children will be learning how to draw plants and flowers through observational drawings. In DT the children will be making their own edible garden.

Maths

- Division Problem Solving - Sharing and Grouping
- Division - Two and Three-Digit Numbers by One-Digit Numbers including Halving
- Multiplication, Division and Fractions - Scaling and Correspondence Problems
- Division - Long Division
- Time - Hours, Minutes, Seconds, Days, Weeks, Months, Years
- Time - Telling the Time (Analogue and Digital) and Estimation
- Time - Duration Securing the Four Operations with Whole Number including Problem Solving
- Place Value and Decimals - Ten Times Greater and Ten Times Smaller
- Place Value and Decimals - Regrouping
- Place Value and Decimals - Estimation, Comparing and Rounding

How to help your child at home:

- Help your child to learn to tell the time.
- Support your child to learn their times tables - by the end of year 4 the expectation is that children will know all of their times tables up to x12.
- Children can access Times Table Rockstars at home, to help them learn their times tables.



PSHE/Circle Time

In PSHE we will look at the overarching theme of "Living in the Wider World". This will include learning about rights & relationships, taking care of the environment and money.

Science

Through the curriculum, pupils will be investigating the question "How does your garden grow?" We will be planting seeds and watching the stages of growth.

How to help your child at home:

Discuss the signs of new life in your local area. Can you name different plants?.

Computing

Children will be learning how to programme using the Scratch programme. They will be learning the basics of coding.

RE

This term we will be learning about Sikhism and Judaism. The children will be learning about key events, traditions and beliefs.

PE

In PE children will be working with our sports coaches on athletics and rounders. They will be preparing for sports day and be learning how to be a team player.
