Art/D&T


Our art topic this term is going to be linked to Andy Warhol and the pop art movement

Maths

- Fluency
- Adding and subtracting fractions
- Fractions of quantities and in context
- Equivalent fractions

How to help your child at home:

- Help your child by creating opportunities for them to practise maths in real-life situations.
- Support your child to learn their times tables - by the end of year 4 the expectation is that children will know all of their times tables up to $\times 12$.
- Children can access Times Table Rockstars at home, to help them learn their times tables.



PSHE /Circle Time

In PSHE we will be focussing on following the revised curriculum. We will look at Health and Well Being this term and start by exploring what is meant by a balanced lifestyle.

Science

Classification and Interdependence

- recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways
- explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment
- recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.

Computing

Children will explore simulations, investigating the structure and exploring how they might be programmed.

RE

In Year 4 we will be looking at pilgrimages across different religions. Places of significant interest to different religious communities and why people visit them.

PE

In P.E. children will be developing their skills in Striking and Fielding. We will relish the opportunity to get them outside, on the field, so please make sure that they have the correct school PE kit.
