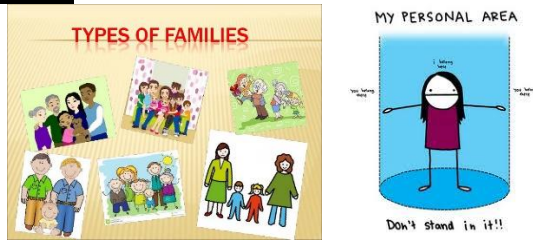


Year 3 Jigsaw Puzzle 5 – Relationships
