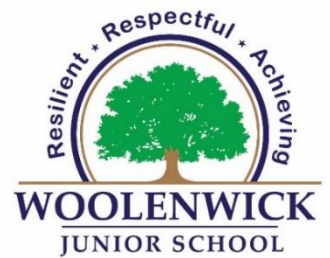
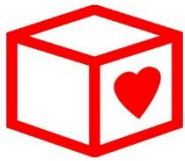

The Red Box Project

Dear Parent/Carer,

We would like to let you know that Woolenwick Junior School has recently joined the Red Box Project, a national community organisation committed to giving young people access to free menstrual products in schools.

As a result, we now have a selection of menstrual products available for students to access during school hours. This includes a range of pads in all absorbencies, night pads (and tampons). It also contains clean underwear, should it be needed. The box is stocked from donations from our local community, who support the project and its aims.

Any student who needs to receive items from the box, whether it's one item to get them through the day or several packs to ensure they're able to attend school throughout their period, will be able to access it at (say where the box is kept here). Students should ask their teacher or a member of the school office admin team to ask for the Red Box where they will be able to take away whatever they need.

We have spoken to the female students in Year 5/6 about the box but you may also want to take this opportunity to talk to your child/ren about their needs and how the box might be able to help them.
